

## Wall Measuring Tips

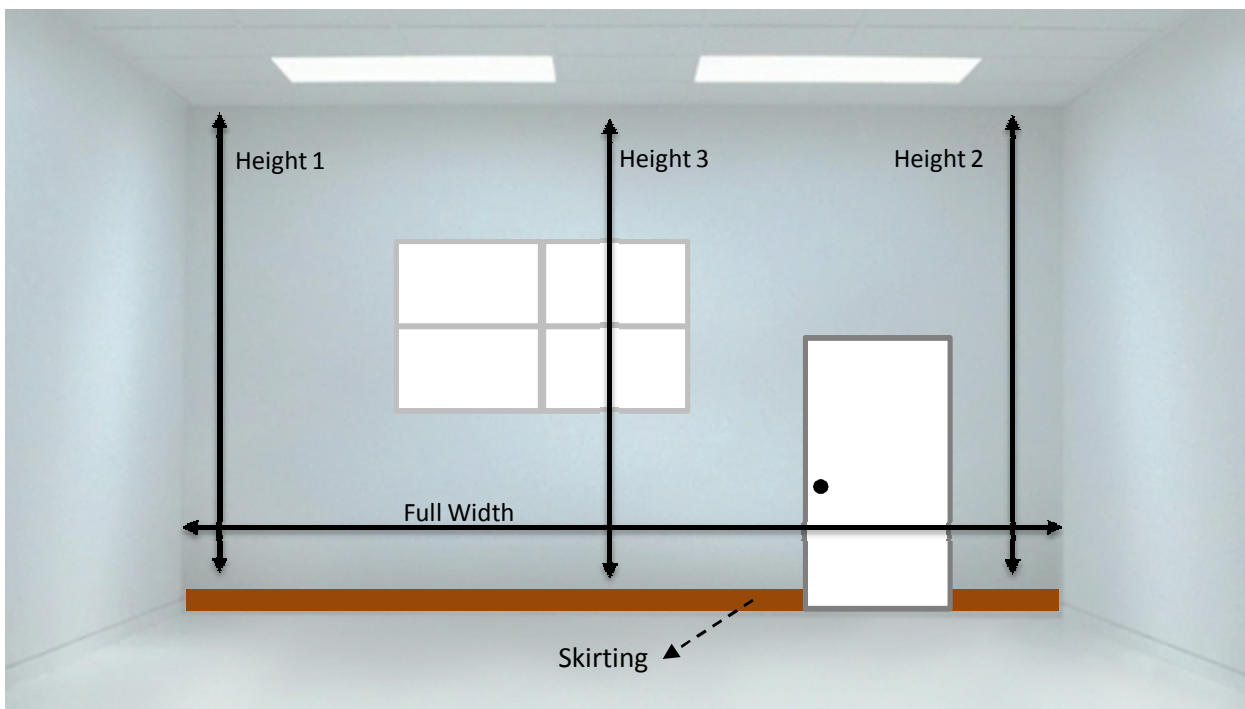
Once you have decided on the wall you want to enhance with a digital wallpaper, you will need to decide what portion of the wall you want covered. Keep in mind that a full wall digital wallpaper is going to offer you the greatest impact and is ultimately the best value for your money. This is one instance where size truly does matter. Furthermore a full wall digital wallpaper will provide extraordinary drama and help you transform a room that surprise everyone! Once you have decided on the perfect size, measure the wall several times to ensure accuracy.

Tips

### Measure on a FULL WALL

Width - Measure the horizontal distance from corner to corner.

Height - We recommend you to measure the vertical height at each corner as walls are never perfectly square. If different, select the greater of the two height measurements.



### Caution Points

- 1) Take the measurement as accurate as possible. We recommend measure in **milimeter (mm)**.
- 2) If your wall comes with doors/windows/other wall decorations, **do not EXCLUDE** them from your measurement. Just ignore them. Note down the full wall width and height.
- 3) **EXCLUDE** the skirting in your measurement.
- 4) Unusual wall? Call us for guides.
- 5) we will create all customised wallpaper based on the specific dimension that you provide. To allow for slightly uneven wall dimensions we add an extra inch of bleed to the height and width of each walpaper section/panel. This extra material can be easily trimmed away while installation.

Before proceed your order, please make sure your wall/target surface is ready for walpaper installation:

- i) If your wall currently covered with wallpaper, please get them removed.
- ii) Your wall/target surface should be **dry and smooth**.
- iii) If your wall is **newly painted**, installation of wallpaper straightaway is not recommended.  
In most of the case, paint take at least a week to fully dry.
- iv) If the wall is a new wall which is **newly built**, the wall must be painted with undercoat.  
Oil-based undercoat is recommended.
